MINISTRY OF ALTAR DRESSING

1. BEFORE MASS ASSIGNED ALTAR DRESSERS RECRUIT THREE PEOPLE TO BRING GIFTS TO ALTAR.

- 2. The dressing of the altar takes place after the Prayer of the Faithful (petitions) when the ushers collect.
- 3. All the needed items will be on the Credence Table (the small table behind the ambo).
- 4. When dressing the altar, one stands in back of the altar facing the congregation.
- 5. Place the altar cloth on top of the altar in the center. Unfold it from each side and then center over the altar. The cloth covers only the top of the altar. Unfold the corporal and place in the center of the altar.
- 6. Place the Sacramentary (the red book from Fr. Ray) on the left side of the altar, slanted to the right.
- 7. Place the candle on its stand on the left side near the corner; and light the candle. Do not place the extra cups on the altar, leave them on the side table.
- 8. Fr. Ray is already plugged into the new sound system without the altar mic. If the mic is needed for concelebrant, it will be there. Place the mic at the center to pick up sound for the hearing-impaired.
- 9. The dressers move to the front of the bema to receive the gifts or take them from Fr. Ray who sometimes now receives them.
- 10. Place the paten, 2 decanters of wine, and the chalice on the corporal. Pour some wine from the smaller decanter into the chalice so that it is less than half full. **All the wine should remain on the altar for consecration.**
- 11. If flowers are brought to the altar, place them on the right side near the front corner of the altar.
- 12. The dressers should move to the front of the altar, Fr. Ray likes to thank you, afterward <u>bow to the altar</u>, and return to your seats.
