Dear Members of St. Vincent de Paul,

I am writing to you to ask you to be a part of our parish campaign for the Financial Aid Endowment at St. James & John School.

Over the 39 years of my ministry here at St. Vincent's, we have worked together to establish a Community of Word, Sacrament and Service, and to ensure its future. We have managed to achieve a lot together. Our parish, though it remains small, is thriving, and its ministries are many. To guarantee the future of our church, we have established our Historic Trust Fund, and have built it up to a little over three million dollars, so that we do not have to fear for the future of our building, and can concentrate on our ministries.

But one of our most effective ministries, our parish school, St. James and John, has to this point remained without a means to guarantee its future. Because so many of the families we serve are poor and need financial aid to match the financial sacrifices they are making for their children, and because we have been unable to raise enough money on an annual basis to meet this need, there is a grave need for a Financial Aid Endowment.
