




Over the past 9 years, the overall mass attendance has changed by +244 persons (--). This compares to a change of -27% in Harbor East Region and a change of -13% throughout the Archdiocese over the same time period.

Mass Attendance - Hispanic





In 2015, a total of 244 persons attended 3 weekend Masses, for an average of 81 persons per Mass. The average weekend Mass used 20% of the 415 seats available. This compares to average utilization of 15% in Harbor East Region and 42% throughout the Archdiocese.



In 2015, the equivalent of 50% of registered persons attended weekend Mass, compared to 33% for Harbor East Region and 28% throughout the Archdiocese. Christmas Mass attendance in 2015 and Easter Mass attendance were 91% and 84% of registered persons, respectively.


Averaged over the past three years, there have been 1.87 baptisms for each funeral. This compares to 1.16 for Harbor East Region and 1.39 throughout the Archdiocese.

Funds devoted to Outreach and Charity were 17% of the offertory. This compares to 4% for Harbor East Region and 6% throughout the Archdiocese.

Over the past 9 years, the offertory has changed by 38%. This compares to a change of -11% in Harbor East Region and a change of 8% throughout the Archdiocese over the same time period.

In 2015, Facilities Expense comprised 16% of Total Operating Expense, compared to 21% for Harbor East Region and 18% for the Archdiocese. Labor & Benefit Expenses comprised 45% of Total Operating Expense, compared to 39% for Harbor East Region and 49% for the Archdiocese.

In 2015, the operating surplus/deficit was +\$4,976. Over the three-year period of 2013–2015, the average operating surplus/deficit was +\$27,105, or +9.9% of the 2015 offertory.
