At all Masses, we offer **MagnifiKids**, a weekly Mass accompaniment. In the Gathering Space, you will find bags of quiet toys for young ones and rockers for parents of babies. Our religious education program for children in grades K-12 is **Faith, Fun Fellowship** (FFF), and it meets on the second and fourth Sundays after 9:30 Mass.

#### ST. V'S SERVICE MINISTRIES

# REMEMBERING THE SAINTS

Throughout the world and throughout history, we have set aside time and tradition to honor the dead. In these practices, we recognize that each person may make a difference in the world. And we remember. We remember our loved ones who were an intimate part of our lives: influential for us, helping us to grow, learn, make good decisions, to celebrate the life we are given. We also



remember those people we never knew personally, but whose sphere of influence was broad, and by whose good example we may choose to live.

At St. Vincent, we celebrate the feast days of All Saints and All Souls with a liturgy that includes images from the Mexican celebration of the Day of the Dead. Parishioners bring to the bema photographs and mementos of their loved ones who have died. A skeleton playfully but reverently sits and watches over these gifts and memories. Behind the skeleton stands a cross, adorned with cheerful marigold blossoms. These images remind both of our own mortality and of the fundamental Christian hope in the resurrection. We joyfully sing together the litany of the saints, asking for prayers of those who go before us and see God. We come to the bema to light candles and to honor our beloved dead by speaking aloud their names. As we mourn our losses and prayerfully remember those we will not see again in this life, we might well be sad. At the same time, through our tears and sorrow, we smile and sing. The Communion of Saints reminds us: our life in Christ, and the love of God for God's children is neither bound nor limited, but goes on.
