UPDATE ON PASTORAL PLANNING

After considering our town meetings, emails and other input from parishioners, our parish council on Tuesday came to the consensus that we should pursue a pastorate with St. Ignatius Church, not St. Leo as the Archdiocese had proposed. This week the Archdiocese hosted a meeting for parishes to give feedback on the proposed pastorates. Representatives from St. Vincent spoke with those from St. Leo, which has also decided to pursue a different pastorate arrangement (Holy Rosary), and with St. Ignatius's representatives. We presented our ideas for change to the proposed model to the Archdiocese. In consultation with St. Ignatius, we will continue to develop more specific feedback to the Archdiocese about how this pairing would benefit our work in evangelization and in living our mission.
