HOMELESS JESUS COMING TO ST. V



In Archbishop Lori's letter on the retirement of our pastor, he announced that St. V is to be the site of a bronze statue known as "Homeless Jesus." While we have not finalized plans for its placement, we anticipate placing it on the corner of Fayette and Front Streets. Installation is tentatively scheduled for the fall. Currently the Archdiocese is displaying a resin replica of the statue in the Basilica. That replica will be displayed in parishes throughout the Archdiocese in the coming months. When the Archdiocese returns it to the artist, work will begin on the bronze version to be placed here.
