### SUMMER SERIES PREVIEW

Starting next week, **July 9**, St. V will take on the *Acts of the Apostles* for our summer series. If you haven't read it recently, you will easily finish the whole thing before next week, at about 18 minutes a day. *Acts* is the story of people called by Jesus, who become confirmed in the Holy Spirit. They learn to organize as a community to live the Good News, and to communicate its light and compassion to the world. Sounds a lot like us here at St V, as we continue to develop evangelization strategies through the Archdiocesan pastorate planning process. Our study of Acts will take two summers: focusing now on the mission of Peter; and next summer, Paul.
