SOCIAL JUSTICE CORNER

Each week, we focus on one of the Southern Poverty Law Center's *Ten Ways to Fight Hate: A Community Response Guide*.

#3 Support Victims - Victims of hate crimes are especially vulnerable. They often feel alone and afraid and need a strong, timely message that they are valued. If you learn of a hate crime in your community, let victims know you care. Surround them with comfort and protection. They have been attacked simply for being who they are — for their disability, their ethnicity, their sexual orientation. Silence amplifies their isolation; it also tacitly condones the act of hate. Often, hate attacks include vicious symbols - a burning cross, a noose, a swastika that evoke a history of hatred. They also reverberate beyond individual victims, leaving entire communities vulnerable and afraid.

Lord God of Love, Instill in our hearts the courage to take concrete steps to achieve peace. Amen
