Each week, we focus on one of the **Southern Poverty Law Center's Ten Ways to Fight Hate: A Community Response Guide**

4. Educate Yourself

Learn who is responsible – A hate group or an individual? Understand the definitions - A hate crime must meet two criteria: A crime must happen and be motivated, in whole or part, by bias. A bias incident is conduct, speech, or expression that is motivated by bias or prejudice but doesn't involve a criminal act. Both demand unified and unflinching denouncement from individuals, groups, and entire communities. Understand the impact - Hate crimes and bias incidents don't just victimize individuals; they torment communities. Know local laws – and work to add missing categories of bias. (race, ethnicity, religion, sexual orientation, gender, gender identity and/or disability).

Lord God of Love, Instill in our hearts the courage to take concrete steps to achieve peace. Amen
