October also happens to be National Coming Out Month. This must be coordinated with the Education & Enrichment Committee to avoid conflict with other planned activities (Alana). • Q1 2020: Arrange a meeting that would include representatives of other parish LGBT ministries to discuss the James Alison article: "Toward Global Inclusion of LGBT People Within the Catholic Communities: A new theological approach". Reach out to Goucher College, Hopkins University, Towson University, Loyola, Notre Dame of Maryland University LGBT groups for participation. (Peggy)
