**November, 2022 - What Impact Did the Videos Shared Make?**

We discussed the black community behind “the veil” and how much is still present. Segregation caused the existence of two worlds. Outside the black neighborhoods, respect was very different based on where one lived. Our black members discussed their realities living with the segregated shops, restaurants, schools, etc. The group shared stories of videos, books or life events that impacted them and events that greatly impacted lives of free and enslaved black people such as the Fugitive Slave Law.

For December since the 3rd Wednesday falls during Christmas week, we asked that people use the month to catch up on some of the fabulous videos.
