Winans, Cherry Hill, Westport, Cutis Bay, Lakeland, Brooklyn and the developing community on the Baltimore Peninsula.

Another event on Thursday, April 20th, was a symposium sponsored by Catholic Charities with Dr. Greer Gordan speaking at Nativity on *Good Trouble: Alliances for Racial Justice.* They also offered the livestream at satellite locations.
